- to comply with the rights and obligations of members in accordance with Art. 11 - 12 of the Articles of Association (see reverse).

I agree that

- my membership data is recorded in the corresponding administration applications (currently "SpielerPlus", "ClubCorner") and can be viewed by other users;
- First and last name, date of entry, membership category and, if applicable, function/role in the club and position on the field as well as photos of me are visible on our homepage and are generally accessible;
- the correspondence takes place entirely by e-mail;

... and note that

- **a passport photo and a copy of the front and back of an official identification document (ID, passport) must be submitted for the player license (excluding active members/players);**
- my membership is provisional for the time being and definitive admission will be by vote at the next ordinary general meeting;
- attendance at general meetings is mandatory for active members in accordance with the Articles of Association or an excuse must be submitted in writing;
- active and passive members may only **resign at the end of the association year** by submitting a written declaration to the Board of Directors with three months' notice;
- the complete **data protection provisions** are listed in the Articles of Association and on our homepage.

CHAPTER 2: MEMBERSHIP

- a) Acquisition of membership
- Art. 3
1 Anyone who recognizes these Articles of Association may apply for membership of the Association.
- Art. 4
1 Applications for membership must be submitted in writing to the association's board of directors.
2 Applications for admission of underage players must be co-signed by the legal representative.
3 The Board of Directors decides on the provisional admission of new members until the next ordinary General Meeting, at which the admission is to be confirmed.
4 The Executive Board may refuse admission without giving reasons.
5 The applicant for admission may appeal against the decision of the Board of Directors to refuse admission within a period of 14 days. The appeal must be submitted to the Board of Directors in writing, stating the reasons, for the attention of the next General Meeting, which will make the final decision on admission. The Board of Directors must provide its decision with appropriate information on legal remedies.
6 The appeal period begins upon receipt of the decision of the Board of Directors. It is deemed to have been observed if the notice of appeal is delivered to the post office on the last day of the period (date of postmark). If the General Meeting falls within the appeal period, any appeal can be lodged and dealt with at the General Meeting.
- b) Categories of members
- Art. 5
1 The association has the following membership categories:
a) Active members - divided into "players" and "training only";
b) Passive members;
c) Free members;
d) Honorary members;
e) Patrons and supporters.
- Art. 6
1 Anyone who has rendered outstanding services to the association can be appointed an honorary member.
- Art. 7
1 Anyone who has rendered uninterrupted service to the Association for 5 years by serving on the Board of Directors or, without time limit, in any other way, may be appointed as an honorary member.
- Art. 8
1 Honorary and free memberships are awarded at the General Meeting at the request of the Board of Directors.
- Art. 9
1 [deleted]
- Art. 10
1 A patron or supporter is anyone who, without having to actively participate in the life of the association, donates at least the amount set by the Board of Directors for patrons or supporters each year.
- c) Rights and duties of members
- Art. 11
1 Members of all categories of the association have the right to
a) to attend ordinary and extraordinary general meetings and, if they are accepted as permanent members, to exercise their statutory voting and election rights;
b) to be informed about the life of the club in an appropriate manner (general meeting, club organ, homepage, etc.);
c) participate in social events organized by the association;
d) to exercise all other rights recognized to them by these Articles of Association or otherwise by the Association.
2 Active members
a) also have the right to take part in training and competitions according to their sub-category;
b) of the sub-category "players" are registered with the "Swiss Football Association" in order to obtain their eligibility to participate in competitions.
c) the subcategory "Players" can be grouped into "Active", "Seniors" or "Veterans" if required/available.
- Art. 12
1 Members of all categories of the association have the duty to
a) to behave faithfully and loyally towards the association;
b) to comply with the statutes, regulations and resolutions of FIFA, UEFA, the SFA, the Zurich regional association and the club;
c) to pay the membership fees decided by the General Meeting in accordance with these Articles of Association;
d) to indemnify the association for any fines and extraordinary costs imposed on the association by the competent association authorities or incurred by the association due to the actions or omissions of members (e.g. in the event of missing registrations, for reminder fees, payment processing fees, etc.);
e) to follow the training and, in particular, match instructions as well as the instructions of the responsible officials (functionaries and coaches) of the club;
f) to fulfill all other duties arising from these Articles of Association or statutory resolutions of the Association.
2 Violations of these obligations may be punished by the Board of Directors with a reprimand or a fine of up to CHF 200 after prior consultation with the member concerned. The exclusion from the association remains reserved. The decision of the Board of Directors is final.
3 Active members in the "players" sub-category who have not met or have only partially met their financial obligations to the club may also be registered with the SFA for boycott in accordance with the provisions of the SFA boycott regulations.
- d) Loss of membership
- Art. 13
1 Resignations of active and passive members and changes of category from active to passive membership can only take place at the end of the association year.
2 Declarations of resignations and changes of category must be submitted to the Board of Directors in writing with three months' notice.
- Art. 14
1 Members in the other categories may declare their withdrawal in writing at any time.
2 Membership expires on the date of resignation.
- Art. 15
1 If there are important reasons, a member can be excluded at any time after a prior hearing by the Association Board.
2 Good cause shall be deemed to exist in particular if the member seriously violates the statutes and/or the interests of the association or has repeatedly defied the instructions of officials (functionaries and trainers) of the association or if the member has not paid the annual membership fee despite a written reminder.
3 The excluded member may appeal against the Board of Directors' exclusion decision within a period of 14 days. The appeal has no suspensive effect. It must be submitted to the Board of Directors in writing, stating the reasons, for the attention of the next General Meeting, which will make the final decision on the expulsion. The Board of Directors must provide its decision with corresponding information on legal remedies.
4 The appeal period begins upon receipt of the decision of the Board of Directors. It is deemed to have been observed if the notice of appeal is delivered to the post office on the last day of the period (date of postmark). If the General Meeting falls within the appeal period, any appeal can be lodged and dealt with at the General Meeting.
- Art. 16
1 Resigning and excluded members of all categories owe the association the full annual membership fee for the current association year. Any further financial obligations become due for payment immediately upon resignation or expulsion.
2 An exit fee may not be charged.
